CLINICAL SUPERVISOR MASTER CLASS

Trauma Informed Supervision: Managing boundaries in practice and professional self-care in supervision

1-day workshop (7 hours) (Course Code: **SING24-MASTERCLASS**)

This 1-day workshop provides existing supervisors with an opportunity to critically examine their practice of competency-based supervision within a trauma-informed practice framework. Supervision approaches to help prevent vicarious trauma, compassion fatigue and burnout will be discussed. An aim of the workshop is to help supervisors strengthen their ability to support supervisees integrate self-care strategies in their practice and identify and manage boundaries in practice when working with risky and challenging clients. Supervisors will learn how to structure supervision to ensure supervisees apply appropriate culturally-safe assessment and trauma-informed treatments which at the same time apply reflective and reflexive practice to heighten supervisee awareness and responsiveness to the possible adverse impact of their trauma work. This includes direct clinical work with clients and within organisations and settings that deal with critical issues/presentations such as emergency services, inpatient services and other services where there are complex at-risk presentations
